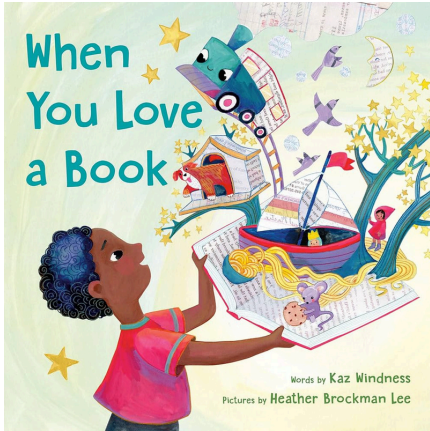




Imagination Library of Colorado Activity Guide

STARTING UP

- Read the title and talk about the objects coming out of the book.

READING THE STORY

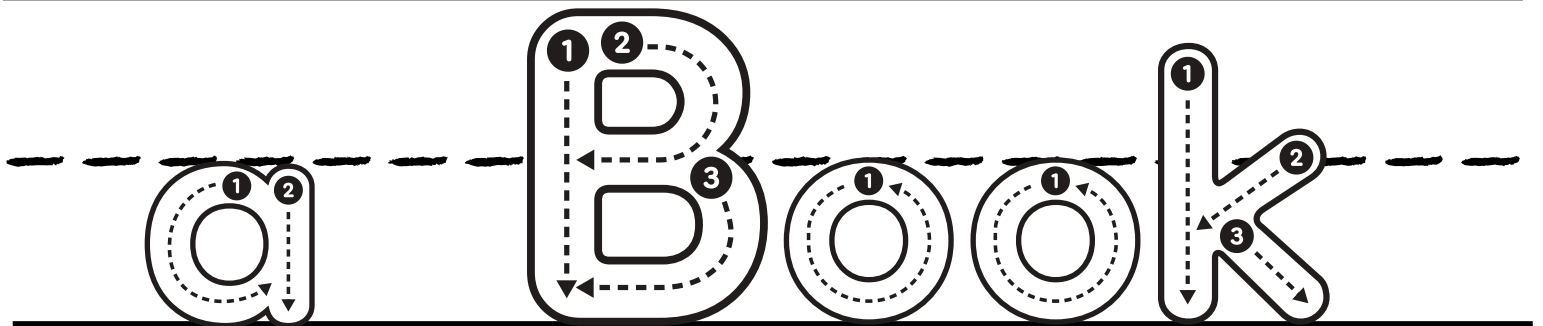
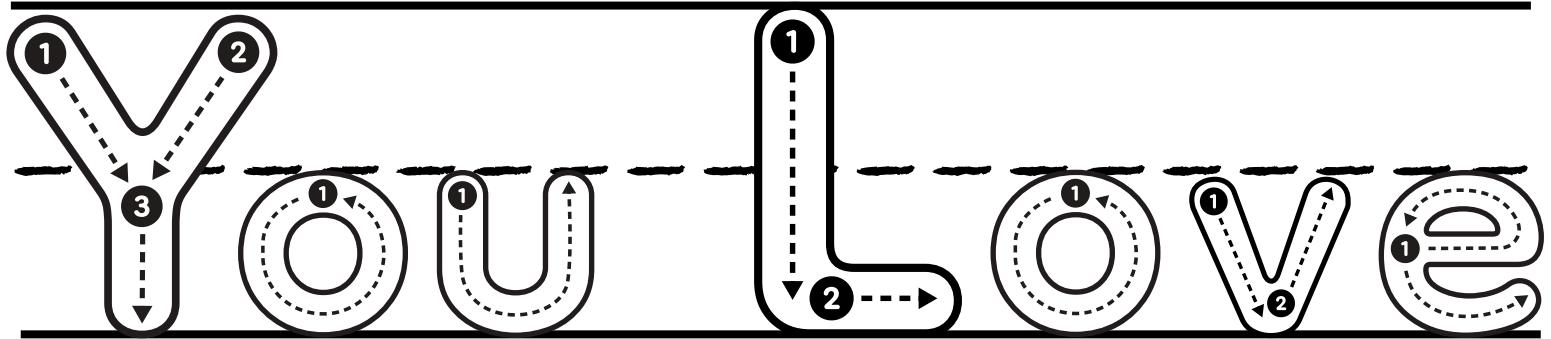
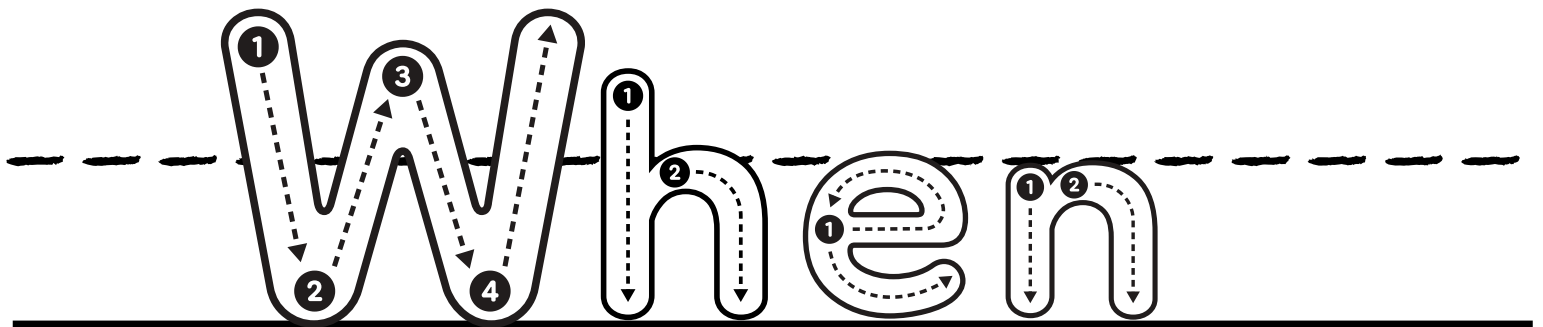
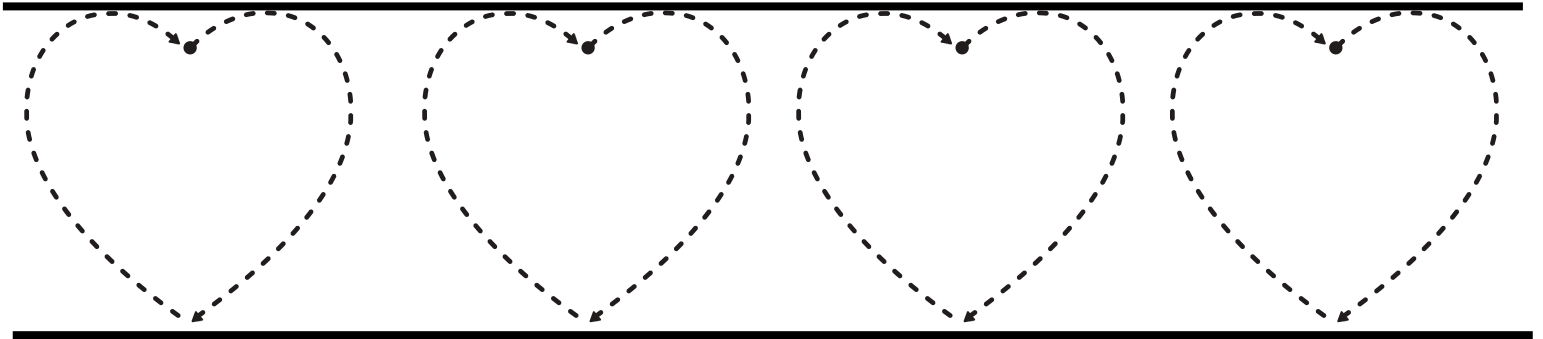
- Enunciate words like "sizes" and "surprises" to enunciate rhyming.
- Ask questions relevant to the context. Do you recognize any stories you have read together?
